Procedures

- Posters displayed show no – smoking.

- We actively encourage people to stop smoking, we will help them to find information on where to get help and support for this.
- Staff are not permitted to smoke during working hours.
- Staff are reminded not to smoke whilst wearing the Mitchell Walk Playgroup polo shirts.

Here at the playgroup we actively encourage the children to live a healthy life style. The staff would discourage any role play that would mimic habits of smoking. The children would not be told it is wrong to smoke. The staff would explain that it is a choice of the individual.
